Be water smart.

Homeowners will need to have a water meter key in order to turn your water on and off at the meter barrel. You can purchase a water meter key at True Value Hardware store.

Use caution when removing your meter cover. Remember to replace the cover and foam plug. The Homeowner is responsible for any damage caused by removing the cover and any leaks on your side of the water meter.

Shut off your valve at the meter barrel when you leave the mountain. Simply shutting off your house valve WILL NOT protect you from the possibilities of a leaking yard hydrant, or underground water lines freezing and breaking. By shutting your valve off at the meter barrel, you will eliminate all possibilities of flooding and damage to your house.
